FARINGDON EAST NEIGHBOURHOOD ACTION GROUP

(Covering Kingston Bagpuize with Southmoor, East and West Hanney, Stanford in the Vale and surrounding villages.)

I am seeking your help as the newly elected Chairperson for the Faringdon East Neighbourhood Action Group. The Group supports neighbourhood policing and helps keep our villages safe and low crime areas by:

- Providing effective two way liaison between local communities and the police.
- Identifying and resolving local community safety issues in partnership with residents, Neighbourhood Watch, Councils and other partner agencies.
- Supporting local crime prevention initiatives with special emphasis on ensuring advice and support is available to the most vulnerable.
- Actively promoting group activities to local communities.

Members of the Action Group include Parish Councillors, Neighbourhood Watch Co-ordinators, residents, a representative from the business community and of course the Neighbourhood Policing Team.

In recent years the group has dealt with priorities relating to road safety outside schools, speeding, anti-social behaviour, hare coursing, rural crime and participation in the community payback initiative.

The group is now planning to help the police further their engagement with rural communities and develop village initiatives which will address issues of most concern, develop the Neighbourhood Watch network and reduce risk for the most vulnerable.

I understand your village has had only limited involvement with the group in the past and wonder if you would like to nominate someone who would be prepared to talk to one of our Neighbourhood Policing Team about this initiative and if possible (but not essentially) represent your village in our Group which meets four times a year for about one hour.

It would be extremely helpful if you could give this matter your consideration and respond accordingly.
